The designer for this property needed a supplier for several items. A call to Aida & Co. along with pictures of the products (or something similar) and a target price got the balls rolling and the goods sourced. In this case, a leatherette stool and woven sea grass baskets were quickly sourced factory direct to the property saving the buyer time and money.

The entire process from start to finish for sourcing the products took less than one week to find a suitable for each item. After that, delivery to property took roughly 90 days.



Hotel Grand Oasis, Cancun, Mexico

When Aida & Co. was approached by the designer for the Oasis Group of Hotels about the seating in the fine dining restaurant, he was in a quandary. The restaurant features a

large open space but the designer wanted it to have an intimate feel. It is the place for honeymooners and others to enjoy a romantic meal and the designer felt that the furnishings should provide both intimacy and comfort.

The designer, of course, had budget constraints so large wing-back chairs were out of the question. Working with a furniture maker in Brazil, Aida & Co. had the factory produce a fully cushioned parsons' style chair with the seat back raised approximately 6" above normal height. That gave the sense of intimacy desired by blocking not only the views behind the diners but also dampening the noise level as voices could not carry outside the table areas.
